NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the Order issued *vide* No. ASDMA.28/2021/326 /Dated the 12.11.2021 by the Chief Secretary, Assam, on improvement of COVID vaccination status in the state, all Heads of offices/departments/establishments of Assam Agricultural University are hereby informed that the relaxation issued for **pregnant women employees and women employees with children of 3 years below** working under their control shall stand withdrawn and all employees (including contractual and fixed pay) except those on authorized leave shall attend office accordingly.

ORDER

No. ASDMA 28/2021/326

Whereas, the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) has vide order of April 20, 2021 issued directives under Clause (B) for pregnant women employees and women employees with children of 5 years or below to work from home irrespective of their grade;

Whereas, the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) has vide order of August 17, 2021 under Clause (C-5) further relaxed the directives for women employees having children to work from home by reducing the age of children to 3 years;

Whereas, the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) has further vide order of October 27, 2021 under Clause (C-1) issued directives for government servants (including contractual and fixed pay) who have taken at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine to attend office, except those in whose case vaccination is contra-indicated as per guidelines issued by the Health Department of Government of Assam and /or such claim is certified by a registered medical practitioner to get themselves vaccinated and attend office;


Whereas, the situation of COVID-19 in the State has been reviewed and the overall scenario in the state has considerably improved;

Whereas, COVID vaccination status has also improved significantly with 95% of the total eligible population in the state have received first dose, many districts nearing saturation and second dose vaccination has also gone up to 31% of total eligible population in the state;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers, conferred under Section 22(2) (h) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee of the State Disaster Management Authority, Assam, do hereby issues the following directions which shall come into force with immediate effect.

1. The relaxation issued for pregnant women employees and women employees with children of 3 years or below working under any Government / PSU / Financial Institutions / Private Organizations shall stand withdrawn.
2. All Government servants (including contractual and fixed pay) except those on authorized leave shall attend office.

Other directives issued vide No. ASDMA 28/2021/304 dated 27th October, 2021 shall remain in force until further order.
